WHO WE ARE

The Clifton Recreation Department is a branch of the City of Clifton designated to service the recreation, health and fitness needs of the community. The City of Clifton is a diversified community with close to 80 thousand residents. Our department has had much success in serving the citizens of Clifton. We have increased and improved the park infrastructure, increased the number and quality of our programs, won several State awards and, most important, have gained the support and admiration of the citizens of our community. We conduct over 160 classes, workshops and camps per year servicing over 4,000 participants, over 80 special events serving over 18,800 participants and over 35 special programs and teams servicing over 4,700 participants. We have over 607 registered volunteers each year and provide areas of play at our 37 parks. The programs provided by the Department are available for preschool through senior citizens and encompass: educational, cultural, social, leadership, athletic, fitness and citizenship and foster a sense of community.

The mission of the Clifton Recreation Department is to provide the community with a wide variety of youth, adult and family activities that offer our citizens the opportunity to use personal leisure time in a viable, productive and gratifying manner at various facilities that provide both active and passive atmospheres while maintaining historical and environmental awareness. The Department staff place both the concerns of the park system and the programming of unique and quality programs at the forefront of our priorities.

OUR NEEDS

Our events are supported, in part, by our operating budget combined with the financial and in-kind donations, of companies, organizations, service clubs and individuals who understand the economics required to develop and support these types of programs. Without, this support we would not be able to provide the quantity and quality of programming that we offer.

CPR/ FIRST AID RALLY

There are two rallies conducted annually with the American Red Cross in an attempt to train as many residents/employees in Clifton in CPR and First Aid lifesaving skills. CPR is conducted in February near Valentine's Day and First Aid is conducted in March, which is Red Cross Month.
